Although my husband and I have been skiing together for almost 30 years, I had never been taken off the ski hill in a sled until the Bridger Bowl ski patrol brought me down the mountain on December 20, 2022. Since there were no spaces available in any Bozeman rehabilitation facility, the hospitalist highly recommended Barrett Hospital for my rehabilitation. I arrived at the Barrett Hospital Rehabilitation Center with two cracks in my pelvis and limited ability to use my legs. The compassionate care I received from the competent interdisciplinary team for two weeks lifted my spirits. With the expertise of the physical therapist and occupational therapist, I used my crutches to walk the halls and witness the many contributions from foundation donors. The dietician-prescribed protein-based diet and the tasty food delivered and prepared by the pleasant cook team helped my pelvis mend. The hospitalists, nurses, nurse assistants and case manager's willingness to help me during this healing process was exceptional. I will be forever grateful for the skills I learned and have recommended the Barrett Hospital Rehabilitation program to my Bozeman community.

Barrett Hospital Foundation began operating in an official capacity in 1989 to secure crucial funding to support programs and services for Southwestern Montana's growing population.




Dig Pink Night




